

EXAMPLE:

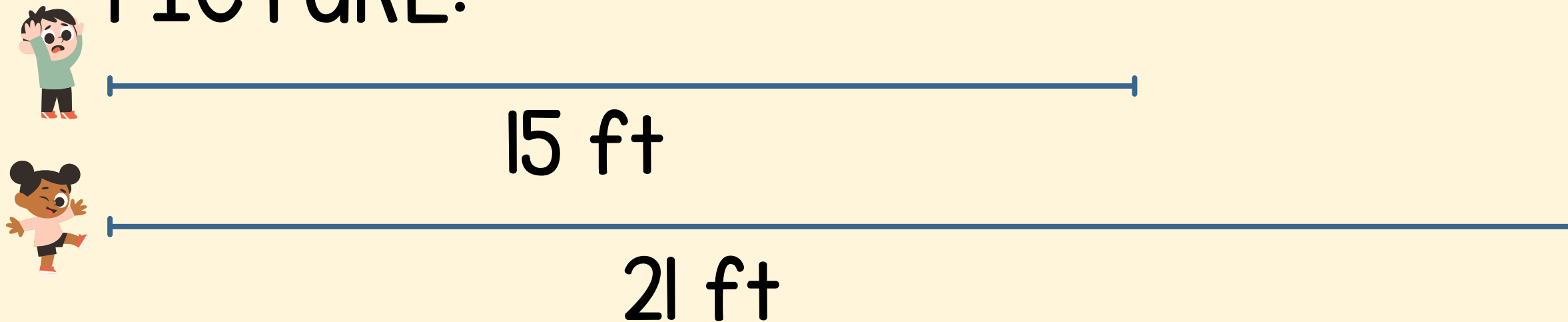
Ben and Beth were throwing frisbees. Ben threw his frisbee 15 ft and Beth threw her frisbee 21 ft. How much further did Beth throw her frisbee than Ben?

EXAMPLE:

NUMBER SENTENCE:

$$21 \text{ ft} - 15 \text{ ft} = 6 \text{ ft}$$

Annalee has two pieces of ribbon. One piece is 32 centimeters in length and the other is 57 centimeters. How much ribbon does she have total?

ANSWER:

$$32 \text{ cm} + 57 \text{ cm} = 89 \text{ cm of ribbon}$$

2.

Mason has a kite with 76 feet of string. His little sister cut off 34 feet of string. How much string does Mason have left?

ANSWER:

$$76 \text{ feet} - 34 \text{ feet} = 42 \text{ feet}$$
