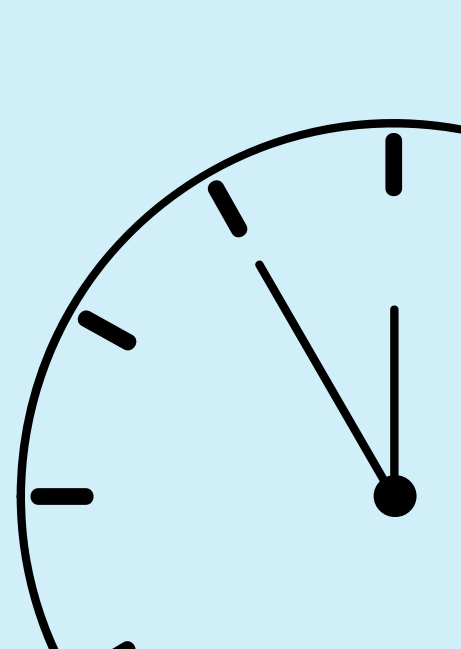
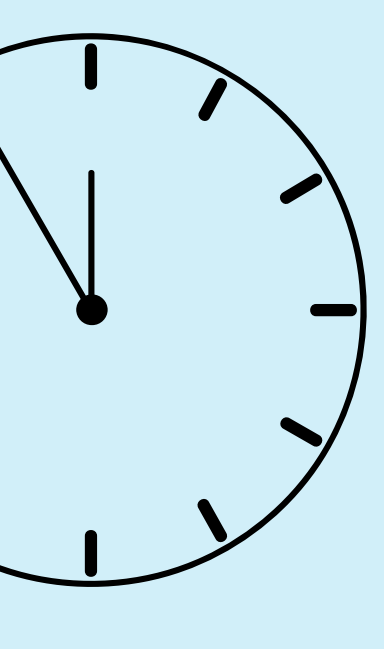
TELLING TIME

PM- From noon to midnight

Each hour is made up of 60 minutes



TELLING TIME

Hour Hand-
The hour hand is
the smaller hand.
You count by 1 when
looking at the hour
hand.



Minute Hand-
The minute hand is
the longer hand. You
count by 5's when
looking at the minute
hand.

MONEY VALUE

Bills- whole values of: 1, 5, 10, 20, or 100\$

Quarters- Worth 0.25¢

Dimes- Worth 0.10¢

Nickels- Worth 0.05¢

Pennies- Worth 0.01¢





MONEY VALUE

4 Quarters = 1 Dollar

10 Dimes = 1 Dollar

20 Nickels = 1 Dollar

100 Pennies = 1 Dollar
