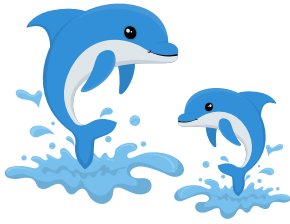


READING COMPREHENSION
