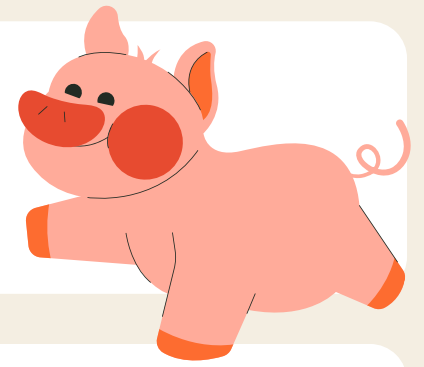


Idioms
