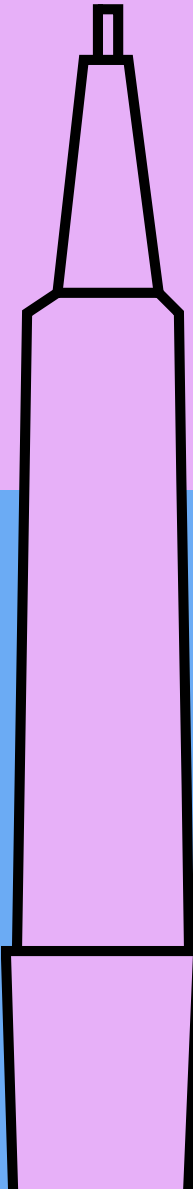
Action Verbs

Action Verbs

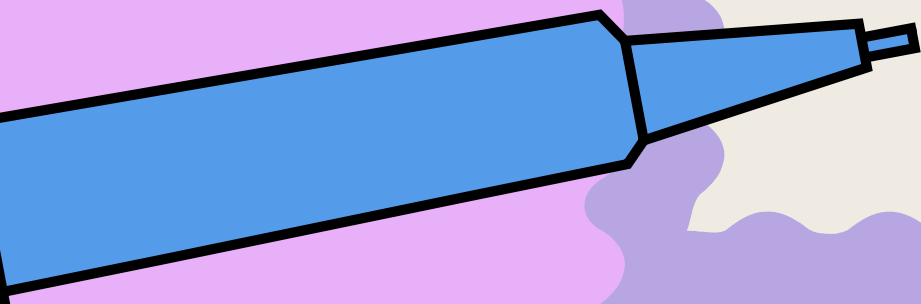
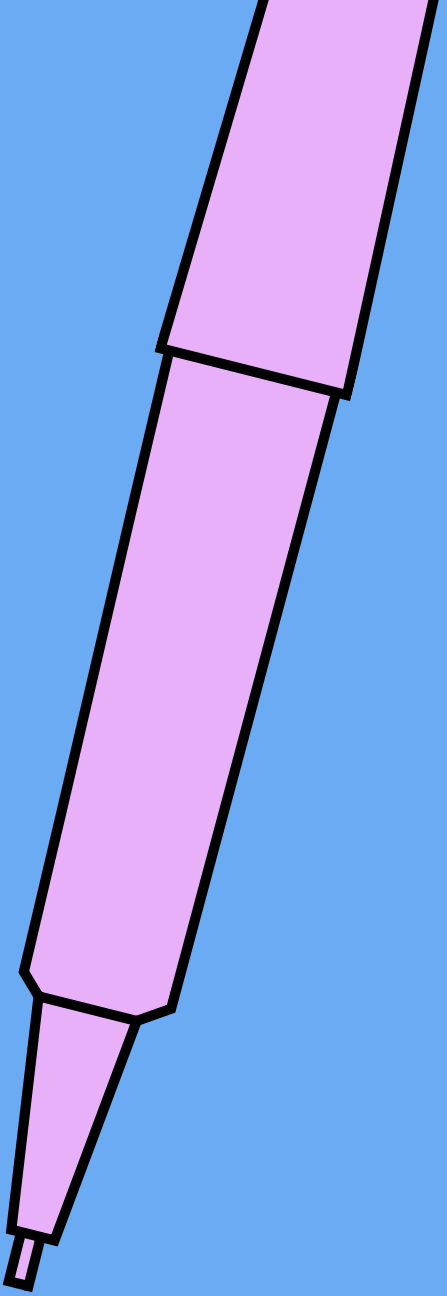


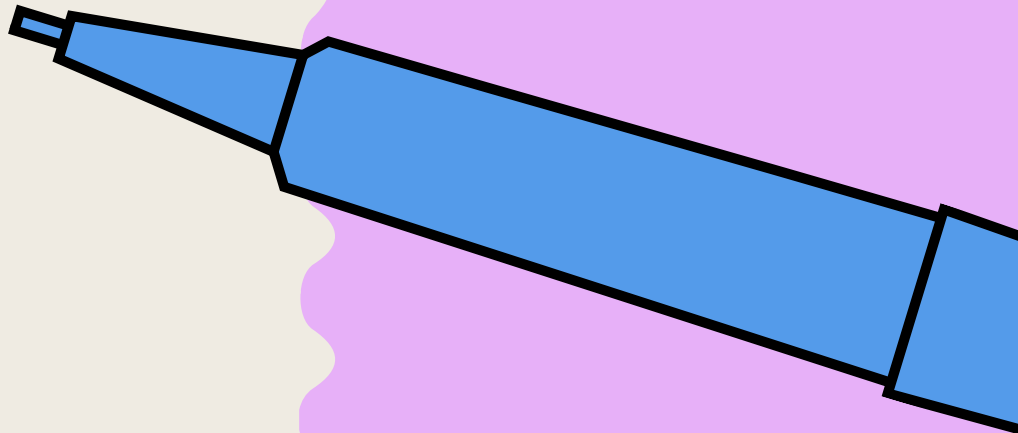
Action verbs give us

Walks is the action verb.

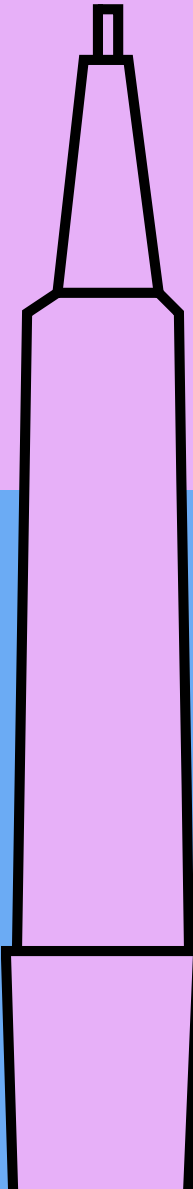




Example

He kicks the soccer ball.

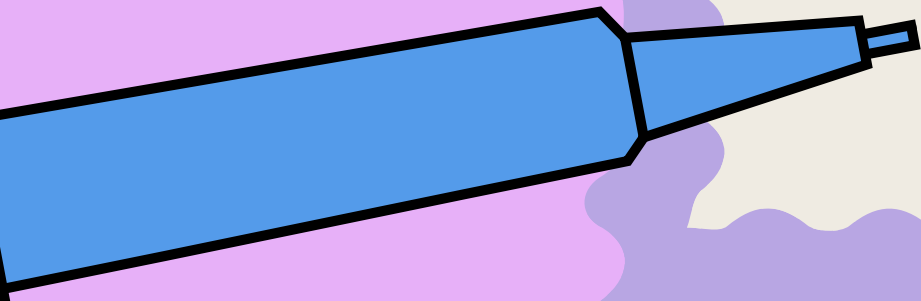
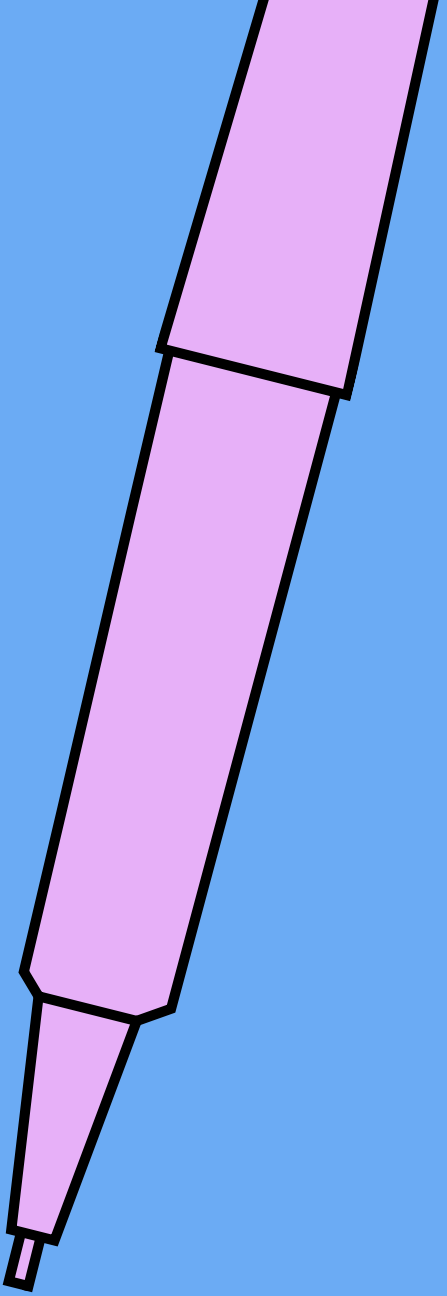

I think about the question.

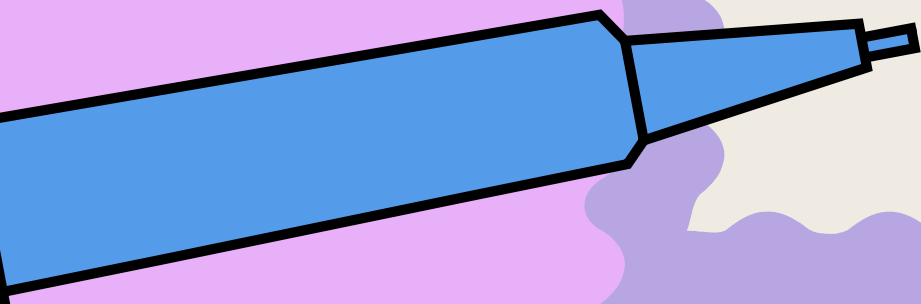
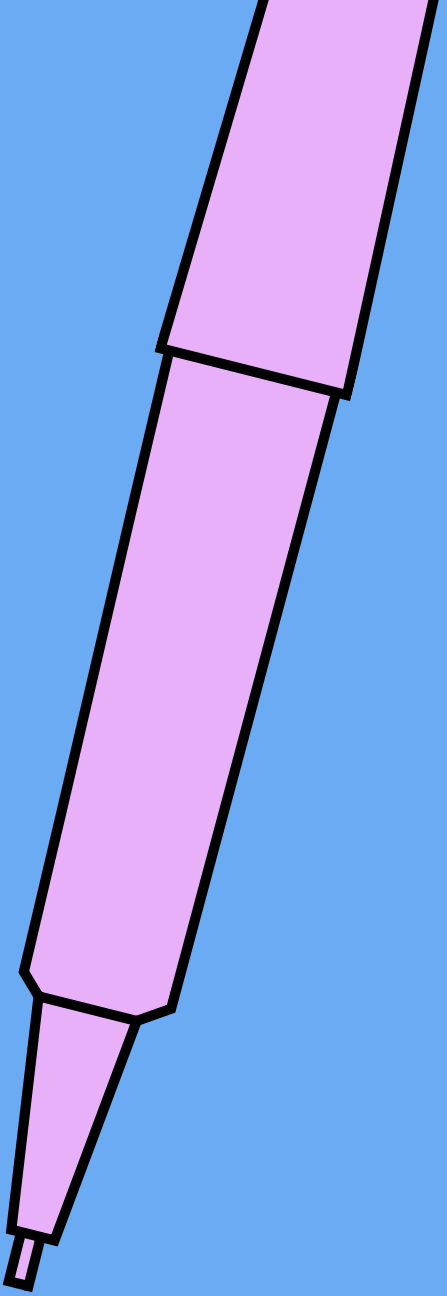

The bird eats the seeds.

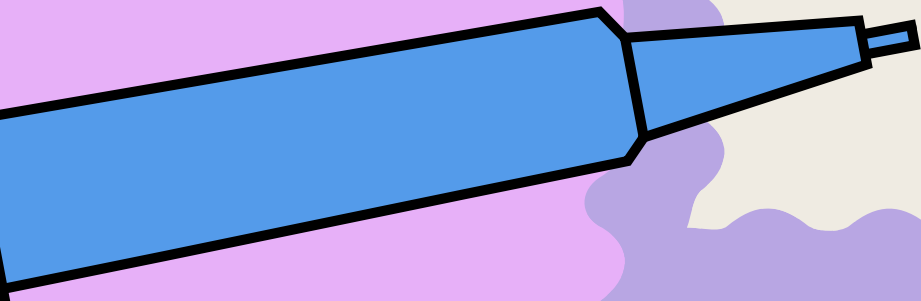
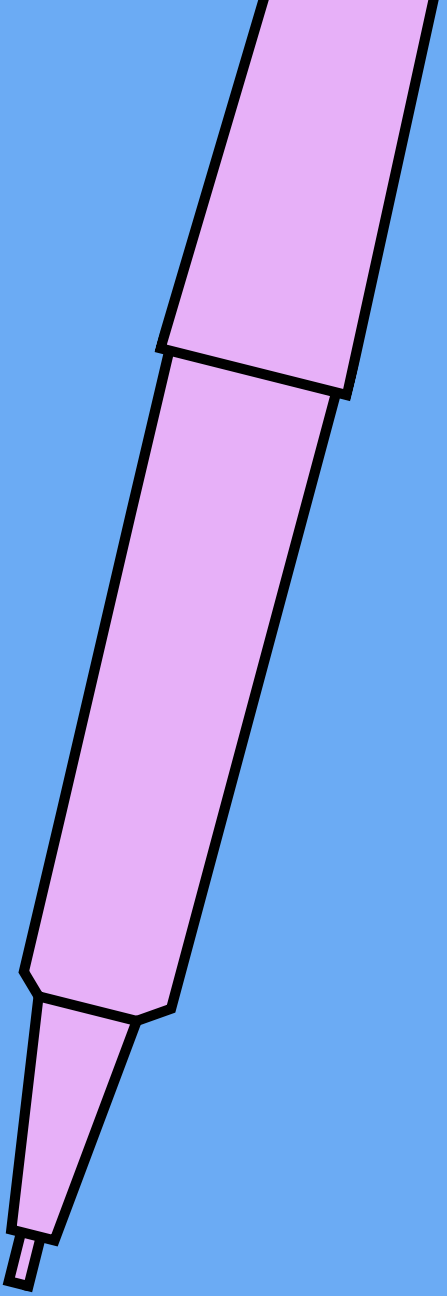

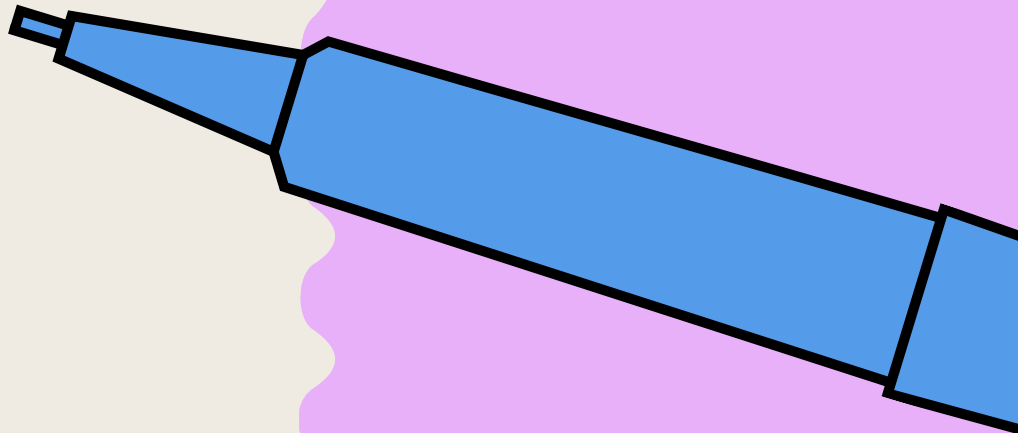


Example

Swim is the action verb.

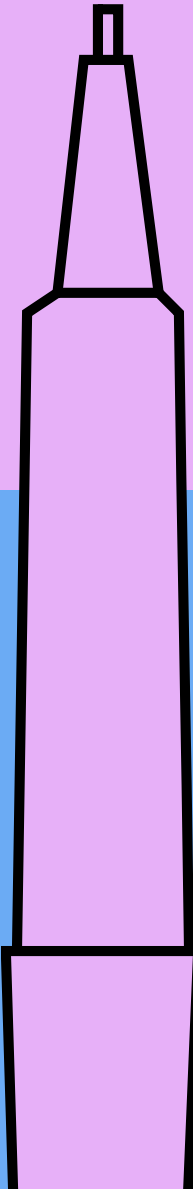
